


- Christ restored His church in these latter days

Preface


- Priesthood authority was divinely restored

- Christ's church is alive today




- Jesus Christ

- Requires our obedience to His gospel principles




- Church of Christ, Complete

 - showing love for Christ and fellow men



 - seeking without finding it




Isaiah 11:11-12

Zechariah 2:4


- Two angels conversing about the rehabilitation of Jerusalem

- Joseph Smith's First Vision
- Church was started by God
- These words are central to the first vision
 - "This is My Beloved Son, hear ye Him."

First Vision

• ... I saw a pillar of light exactly over my head, above the brightness of the sun; which descended gradually until it fell upon me ... When the light rested upon me I saw two personages (whose brightness and glory defy all description) standing above me in the air. One of them spake unto me, calling me by name, and said, (pointing to the other) ...


• ... This is My beloved Son, hear Him."









- Metallic Plates and Inscriptions
- Found in 1936
 - Darius the Great
 - King of Persia
- Inscribed in gold and silver plates
 - Dated 516 B.C.
 - Metal was shining brightly when these plates were discovered












- Joseph and Oliver

 - Authorized Priesthood






- The Church Complete
- Restored in the original, correct order
- Not the work of human planning
 - Result of Heavenly powers
 - Jesus Christ directed its formation



- Jesus on the Mount of Olives
- Matthew 23:36-37
- Those who believed Him should be gathered in one place
- New Jerusalem, Zion, a gathering place for the Saints today
 - Doctrine & Covenants 57: 1
 - Christ directed through revelation today




- The Kirtland Temple
- Move to Kirtland
 - A step toward gathering to Independence, MO
- Sidney Rigdon
- Temple built by the command of God
- No secret services
- Built through sacrifice of the people




- Missionaries Under Endowment Power
- Elders taught at the School of the Prophets in Kirtland
- Sent forth in all directions
 - Including overseas
- 200,000 people converted in just 8 years
 - 67,000 in England



- Far West Area
- Religious persecution
 - Driven out of Clay and Ray counties in 1836
 - Out of Kirtland in 1838
- Moved to Far West between 1836 and 1838
- Driven out of Missouri by the State militia in 1839
 - 300 Saints died during this expulsion






- Mob Violence at Carthage, Illinois
- Meant to disrupt the church




- Joseph Smith, Jr.
- Slain by the mob on June 27, 1844






- Joseph Smith, III
- Presided over the church from 1860 to 1914




- Frederick M. Smith
- Presided over the church from 1915 until his death in 1946




- Israel A. Smith
