

Circular Letter—Fifth Quorum of Elders.

LAMONI, Iowa, June 18, 1902.

Dear Brother: According to quorum action we send you this circular letter. Herein are embodied the principal rules for our government as members of the quorum and instructions pertaining to our work.

It is important to keep accurate account of work done so that we may be able to report according to the requirements of the church. Reports should be made out for the year ending the last day of February and mailed March 1 of each year to the secretary. Blanks for your annual report will be sent you in ample time. Should you, for any reason, fail to receive your report blank by February 15, then inform the secretary of the fact and you will be provided with one immediately.

The quorum refuses to receive or retain, as members, any who use tobacco or strong drink, and expects its transgressing members to so report.

Since 1885 it has been asked that each member send fifteen cents or more annually for the defraying of quorum expenses. These dues should accompany your annual report.

If you desire an appointment as a missionary you should communicate the fact to the missionary in charge of the field wherein you reside, giving him information relative to the number of dependents, family allowance needed, and preference, if any, in field.

Because of the absence of your secretary from the continent he has selected as his assistant Bro. C. I. Carpenter, to whom all correspondence should be directed until the next meeting of the quorum when it will be its privilege to select a secretary.
